Horse Show Information

We start beginners and finish winners!

This will be a fun day! Please read all of this information and always be a good sport!

WHAT TO WEAR

English attire includes Helmet; Navy blue, dark green, black or brown single breasted blazer jacket; shirt that is a button-down collar with tire, or turtleneck; English riding pants; short English boots that zip or tie or western boots; Girl's hair should be in a bun.

Jacket, shirt and/or tie can be used or purchased at Goodwill.

Western attire includes Helmet; western shirt; western vest; jeans; western boots; western belt; girl's hair should be in a bun.

ENTRY FEE

All entries are non-refundable. No refund, transfer or make-up of show entry.

WHAT TO BRING TO THE SHOW

Folding chair; lunch; drinks; snacks; camera and or video camera.

Friends and family are welcome, but are not permitted inside the horse stalls

WHAT NOT TO BRING TO THE SHOW

Dogs, cats, baseballs, basketballs, golf clubs, footballs, soccer balls, etc are not permitted at the show. Everyone should come to the show to support the students. Please keep a watchful eye on all small children, for their safety. NO smoking or vaping on 3-C Farm property, anywhere! Also, NO GLASS CONTAINERS are permitted.

AWARDS

1st place trophy and rosettes will be given in all classes except the games class (ribbons will be given in the games class). High Point and Reserved Champion of the day will be given at the end of the show.

Arrive dressed, groom your horse. Bring your show schedule to know when to be ready.

GIRLS WITH SHORT HAIR

Cover hair with a hair net, then helmet

GIRLS WITH LONG HAIR

Please have your hair in a low bun or ponytail. Buns and ponytails must be low on your head to allow your helmet to fit properly. Get 2 hair nets and bobby pins (not hair pins). Pull hair back into a low ponytail and rat up and put hair net over hair and bobby pin all around. Or braid long/thick hair and cover with 2 hair nets.
